


Please read this document in its entirety!!

Please **stay home** if you have are experiencing any of the following:

Also, if you have recently been in contact with an individual who is positive COVID-19 diagnosis, please stay at home.

We all have a role to play in protecting our community from contagious illnesses, including potential exposure to COVID-19. For the safety of all participants please adhere to the following procedures upon your arrival to our check-in site.

A failure to adhere to any of the following procedures may result in the immediate forfeit of your participation in this trip and you will be asked to leave.

Arrival & Parking

1. Please park and remain in your vehicles once you arrive.
2. Once you have parked please **TEXT** this number, 678-899-3561, and let us know you know you have arrived, please include a vehicle description.
3. Once a Georgia Conservancy representative has arrived at your vehicle, taken your temperature, and given you a wrist band you may exit your vehicle. **Please, for the safety of everyone, have everyone in your vehicle wear a mask during this process and leave it on unless otherwise directed by the Georgia Conservancy Trips Director.** We will have extra masks on site if you need one.
4. Anyone found to be running a fever will be asked to stay in the vehicles and return home. To save yourselves the potential of a wasted trip, please check the temperature of all members riding in your vehicle before leaving home.

Exiting Your Vehicle and Staging

1. Upon exiting your vehicle, please leave your mask on at all times and maintain social distancing from other participants.
2. When we circle up for opening talks, please continue to maintain social distancing and leave your masks on.

Hiking

1. Yes, we understand that strenuous activity can be more difficult while wearing a mask. Regardless, we require all participants to wear their

mask at all times while hiking on the trail. Please consider this before registering for this trip.

2. If a snack or water break is required, please remove yourself at least 6 feet away from the rest of the group. It is recommended and encouraged that you wait for one of the various stopping points along our tour to do this.
